

ENTERING GRENADA

A Traveler's Guide

Grenada's colour code system represents low, medium and high risk regions. The classification is based on the European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control - "**COVID-19 14-day case notification rate per 100,000 population**".





HEALTH DECLARATION

You must complete and submit the Government of Grenada's Health Declaration form prior to departure.

Non-nationals must have travel insurance to cover COVID-19, or declare that they will bear the cost for treatment and isolation.

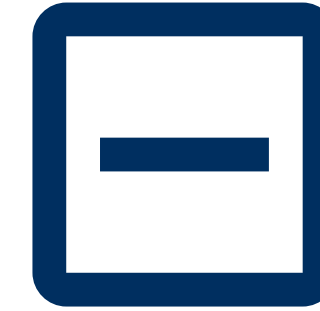


CONTACT TRACING

You are required to download the Government of Grenada's Contact Tracing App prior to departure.

The App must be kept on your phone for the duration of your quarantine period. Failure to comply will result in a fine of \$1,000 EC.

You will be required to wear a geofencing watch for 14 days.



NEGATIVE PCR TEST

You are required to present a certified copy of a negative PCR test that was conducted within 7 days of travel. **This only applies to passengers coming from a "medium and high-risk" country.**

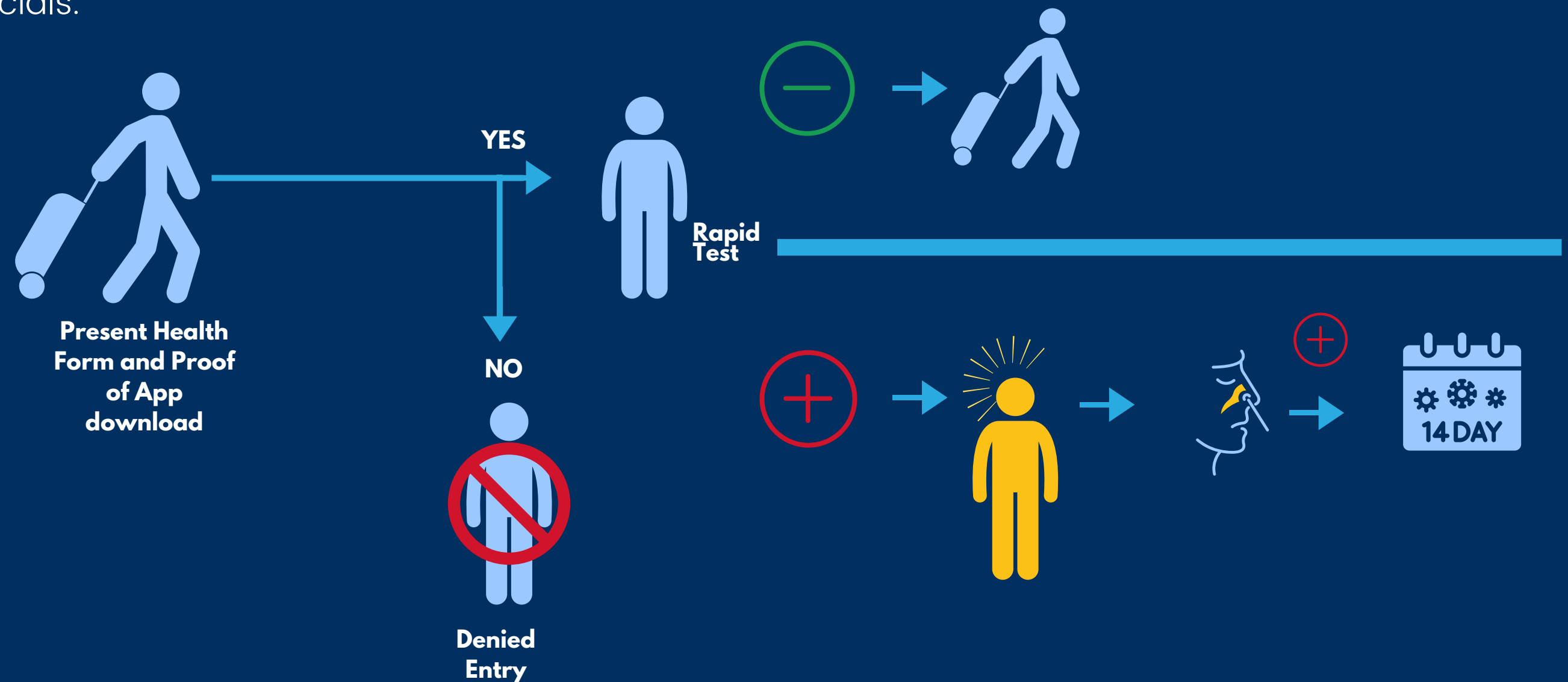

You must present a negative PCR test at point of entry into Grenada, or you will be denied entry.

Have a safe flight!

LOW RISK

- No tests required prior to arrival. Rapid Test upon arrival.
- Present health form and proof of app download upon arrival
- Test negative on Rapid test - Limited movement for 10 days.
- Test positive on Rapid test then you must undergo a PCR test and await the results (24-48 hours) in a state approved facility
- If you test negative on PCR - Limited movement for 10 days.
- If you test positive on PCR you are required to spend 14 days in a state approved quarantine facility (at traveller's expense) until deemed medically cleared after testing negative twice on PCR tests within 48 hours - at the discretion of health officials.



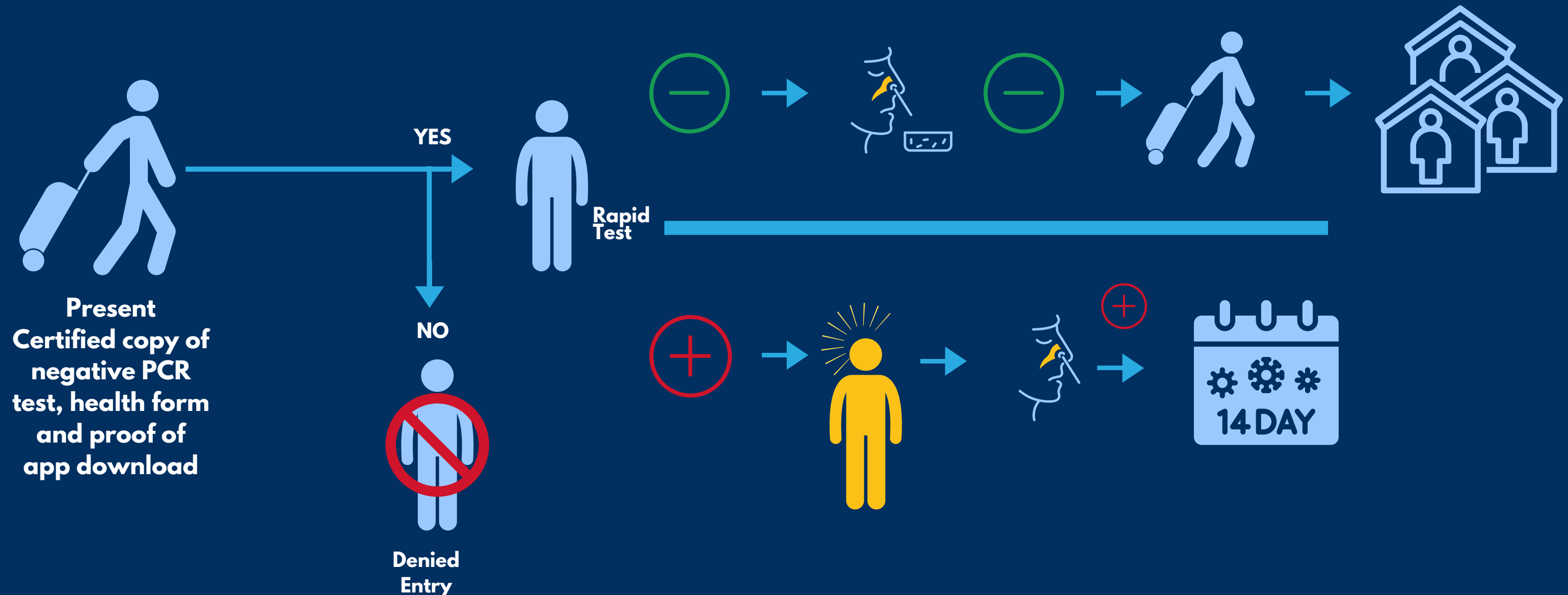
MEDIUM RISK

BEFORE DEPARTURE – Negative PCR test taken no more than 7 days before departure

UPON ARRIVAL – Present health form, negative PCR test results and proof of app download

TESTING – All passengers will be given a Rapid test upon arrival, and a PCR test within 48 hours.

- Negative Rapid test result – Approved quarantine facility for up to 48 hours pending PCR test results
- Positive Rapid test result – State quarantine facility for an average of 48 hours pending PCR test results
- Negative PCR result – Approved accommodation with limited movement.
- Positive PCR result – Required to spend 14 days in a state approved quarantine facility (at traveller's expense) until deemed medically cleared, after having two negative PCR tests within 48 hours – at the discretion of health officials.



HIGH RISK

BEFORE DEPARTURE – Negative PCR test taken no more than 7 days before departure

UPON ARRIVAL – Present health form, negative PCR test results and proof of app download

- All passengers will be PCR tested within 48 hours of arrival, and will be required to spend up to 14 days in a state approved quarantine facility (at traveller's expense).
- Individuals will be deemed medically cleared after testing negative twice on PCR tests within 48 hours – at the discretion of health officials.
